



Conservation Internship

The Tracy Aviary Conservation Internship is six months long, from 1 April to 1 October 2015, and is designed to provide the training required for a Biology/Ecology/Zoology student or naturalist interested in increasing their experience in field bird survey methods, data entry, and public participation in science. Under direct supervision of the Conservation Scientist the intern will:

- Gain hands-on experience with citizen science projects
- Gain hands-on experience with field training for volunteers
- Learn database and data entry basics
- Follow specific data entry protocols and quality control quality assurance process
- Observe and/or participate in bird surveys
- Maintain up-to date bird lists
- Assist with website updates
- Participate in different conservation projects as opportunities allow

Education: Student or demonstrated experience in the fields of Biology, Ecology, Zoology or similar field.

Experience: Three months experience working with data entry and field work in ornithology (desired but not necessary). **Bilingual candidates (Spanish) are encouraged.**

Utah residents will be given preference. The internship is 25 to 30 hours a week. Tracy Aviary provides a small monthly stipend. This is a great opportunity to gain experience in data entry protocols, field ornithology, and public participation in science. Position is open until filled.
