



Wildlife Avian Technician

Environmental Resource Management (ERM), Utah National Guard (NGUT)

Description

NGUT-ERM is looking for a qualified technician to work with migratory birds conducting avian transect monitoring during the summer of 2016 at Camp Williams. Transects were established in 1993 and monitoring will build upon 20 years of data and analysis, including Master's theses.

The technician must demonstrate experience or training in audible bird call and visual recognition. The technician must document ability to work independently and able to hike cross-country in rugged, heavily vegetated terrain during hot, dry weather. Monitoring, analysis and reporting will take most of the summer: applicants must document experience in analysis or reporting of wildlife or other scientific data. Remaining time, including during heavy training or inclement weather, will be spent developing, and possibly implementing, a project-migratory bird survey Standard Operating Procedure. Technician should be able to use Microsoft Office and have basic experience with GPS.

Position reports to NGUT Natural Resource Manager. At summer's end, technician will give quality checked data and report on monitoring, SOP for project-migratory bird surveys, and any project-migratory bird survey reports and data.

May-August 2016.

Candidate has training or education in ornithology or demonstrated experience in bird call recognition.
