



Wildlife Technician Summer 2016

Environmental Resource Management (ERM), Utah National Guard (NGUT)

Description

NGUT-ERM is looking for a qualified technician to assist with wildlife monitoring and management, analysis and reporting during the summer of 2016 at Camp Williams (20 miles south of Salt Lake City). The technician will do various wildlife monitoring as described in the Integrated Natural Resource Management Plan (INRMP), including: Bird of Prey Surveys, wind turbine surveys, motion camera surveys, and other. Work will include assisting bird and wildlife damage mitigation and INRMP wildlife revision, as well as other project assistance and implementation. Monitoring, analysis and reporting will take most of the summer: applicants must document experience in analysis or reporting of wildlife or other scientific data. Technician may assist with other natural resources work depending on need.

The technician must document ability to work independently and able to hike cross-country in rugged, heavily vegetated terrain during hot, dry weather. Technician should be able to use Microsoft Office and have basic experience with GPS. Position reports to NGUT Natural Resource Manager. At summer's end, technician will give quality checked data and report on monitoring and the various other assignments.

May-August 2016.

- Full-time (40 hr/wk), temporary. No benefits.
- Normal NGUT hours: M-TH 0600-16:30.
- Employment will end at summer's end.

Candidate must have training, education or experience in wildlife management or biology.

- Candidate demonstrates physical fitness to meet field operating requirements.
- Candidate documented experience or education relating to analyzing and reporting on scientific data.
