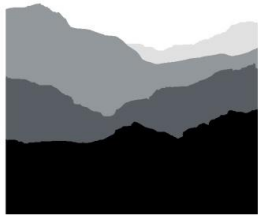


Utah Open Lands Volunteer Internship

Title: **GIS Specialist**

Job Description: Assist with all aspects of the GIS program, including: mapping of field data, GIS data research, development of GIS scripts, maintenance of data archives.

- **Mapping including special requests and field data such as landcover;**
- **Inspect, evaluate, and report GIS data for selected areas;**
- **Create and improve automation of common stewardship GIS tasks;**
- **Maintain GIS data archives;**
- **Interact with ESRI and other GIS specialists.**
