The School of Biological Sciences is accepting proposals from undergraduates majoring in Biology who wish to participate in a research project with faculty in the School of Biological Sciences. Funding is available for several awards. Awards range in size from \$2000 to \$4000 and can be spent through December 15, 2020.

Application Packet:

- Letter of support from tenured or tenure-track faculty PI
- Attach one-page description of your research

Eligibility:

- Undergraduate Biology Major
- Will work in the lab of a tenured or tenure-track faculty member in the School of Biological Sciences and will continue this project through December 15, 2020 (may currently be associated w/ this lab)
- Has not received an undergraduate research award previously from the Department of Biology or School of Biological Sciences.
- Cannot be receiving UROP or ACCESS funds during this same period.
- Will develop and present a poster on the research project during the School's Science Retreat in August, 2020.
