The School of Biological Sciences is accepting proposals from undergraduates majoring in Biology who wish to participate in a research project with faculty in the School of Biological Sciences. Funding is available for several awards. Awards range in size from \$2500 to \$5000 and can be spent through December 15, 2025.

Application Packet:

- Completed Application Form signed by faculty and student
- Letter of support from tenured or tenure-track faculty PI
- Attach one-page description of your research, and prior research experience, and your career goals

Eligibility:

- Undergraduate Biology Major
- Will work in the lab of a tenured or tenure-track faculty member in the School of Biological Sciences and will continue this project through December 15, 2025 (may currently be associated w/ this lab)
- Has not received an undergraduate research award previously from the School of Biological Sciences.
- Cannot be receiving UROP or ACCESS or SRI funds during this same period.
- Will develop and present a poster on the research project during the SBS Science Retreat (date TBA)
